

Declaration of Academic Cooperation
Between
International School of Business and Research (ISBR), India
And
France International Graduate Schools (FIGS), France

International School of Business and Research, India and France International Graduate Schools (FIGS), France are pleased to enter in an agreement to promote scholarly cooperation, mutual understanding and friendly relationships through the following:

- a) Exchange of Academic information and development of syllabi
- b) Offer the academic progression to the existing students of ISBR
- c) Develop joint certification courses
- d) Offer short term programs to the existing students of ISBR

General Terms of the Agreement

- a) The Agreement will come into effect on the date of signing for 5 years
- b) Amendments and additions may be made to the agreement subject to the consent of the parties
- c) Financial obligations in regard to programs and exchanges will be discussed and agreed upon separately by the parties
- d) All the activities of FIGS for the smooth operation of admission process shall be handled from New Delhi office

APPENDIX

- 1) FIGS and ISBR agree to send lists of appropriate and available course with their descriptions in English, so that students participating in these programs can prepare their period of study abroad in the respective institutions with a "Learning Agreement".
- 2) ISBR will provide the appropriate counselling and other assistance to FIGS students and FIGS will provide the appropriate counselling and other assistance to ISBR students. At the end of the period of study ISBR and FIGS will send an official transcript of credits for each student studying at ISBR and FIGS.
- 3) ISBR and FIGS agree to establish a transfer mechanism for the Undergraduate Students of ISBR to go to FIGS upon successful graduation to pursue a 1 year Master's Program at the M2 Level.
- 4) ISBR and FIGS agree to establish a transfer mechanism for the BCA/B.Tech & BE students in IT and Computer Science upon successful completion of the course to Pursue 1 year Master's Program (M2 Level) in IT at EPSI.
- 5) ISBR's 1 year PGDM students get a transfer into your M2 program at the Masters Level subject to eligibility
- 6) EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS
 - a) ISBR and FIGS agree that the administrative and educational requirement of both institutions shall be respected and that all applicable rules, regulations and policies will be followed.
 - b) Any academics credit earned at the host institution may be transferred back to the home institution in accordance with procedures determined by the latter.
- 7) FINANCIAL SUPPORT
 - a) The student participants in the exchange program will pay the required tuition fees for full-time study to their home institution and no such tuition or fees will be charged to the student at the host institution.
 - b) An exception to ^{3a}~~7a~~ will be made in the case where there is an imbalance in the numbers participating in the exchange (Above 10 numbers). Students from FIGS will then be expected to pay the appropriate tuition fees at ISBR and ISBR students will be expected to pay the appropriate tuition fees at FIGS. Director of International Relations at ISBR and the Director of International Relations at FIGS are responsible for assuring the appropriate invoicing for



tuition fees when an imbalance occurs with mutual discussion and consent. The exchange flow will be reviewed at the end of each three years period. No imbalance shall be deemed to occur if for reasons beyond the control of both the schools.

- c) The International travelling expenses of the students participating in this program and the related expenses including but not limited to books, food, lodging and medical care, shall be borne by the students.

- d) The home institution must insure that students participating in this program have the necessary insurance cover.

8) ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIP

ISBR and FIGS agree to promote this academics partnership through facility exchanges, joint research projects and any other activities that help to promote the exchanges between the two institutions, by mutual agreement of the respective institutional directors.

9) ASSIGNMENT

Neither party to this agreement shall have the right to assign any duty or responsibility arising, hereunder without written consent of the other party.

10) MODIFICATIONS

ISBR and FIGS agree to the full and complete performance of the mutual covenants contained herein and that this Agreement constitutes the sole, full and complete agreement by and between the parties, and no amendments, changes, additions, deletions or modifications to or of this Agreement shall be valid unless reduced to writing, signed by the parties and attached hereto.

11) TERMINATION

- a) This Agreement shall be effective from the day it is signed by both parties.
b) This Agreement is renewable with the mutual consent of both the parties on the terms and conditions for another FIVE (5) years unless written notice is given by either party ninety (90) days prior to the termination date.
