



LETTER OF INTENT FOR AN ACADEMIC CO-OPERATION BETWEEN

KENT INSTITUTE AUSTRALIA (KIA) &

INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL OF BUSINESS & RESEARCH (ISBR BUSINESS SCHOOL)

The ISBR BUSINESS SCHOOL and KENT INSTITUTE OF AUSTRALIA

with the objective of fostering academic exchange and cooperation between two parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Both parties shall encourage the following activities in academic and educational fields, where they have mutual interest:
 - I. Summer School Participation
 - II. Promote KIA's higher education programs and vocational education and training courses to Indian students to study at KIA in Australia
 - III. Joint research activities
 - IV. Faculty exchange
 - V. Student exchange
 - VI. Exchange of research results, academic publications and other academic information
 - VII. Other academic exchange upon which both parties agree

- 2. The implementation of each program based upon this LOI shall be negotiated and agreed upon by both parties under a separate MOU prior to the initiation of the particular program.
- 3. This LOI will be effective from October 2016, commencing on the date of the signature by both parties. The period of validity will be decided by consent of both

parties. This LOI may be terminated, with twelve months written notice to the other party, without prejudice to the completion of ongoing student exchange programs.
